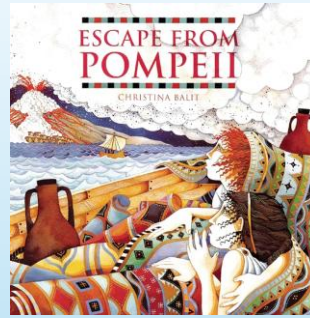


Author of the Term

- Addition and Subtraction - add and subtract 4-digit numbers; estimation

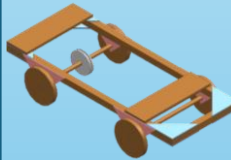
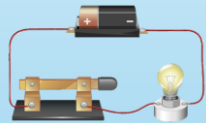
