





PE Timetable

Maths



We will let you know which Maths set your child will be in. We will be using the baseline tests and all the information we have gathered to set the children.






- Reading Diaries

 - Letters for different purposes






- Children will be given a termly spelling list, which will be on the school website.

- There will be continuous work on suffixes in addition to learning high frequency words.




Homework




- Two pieces are set per week

Being Prepared!


