
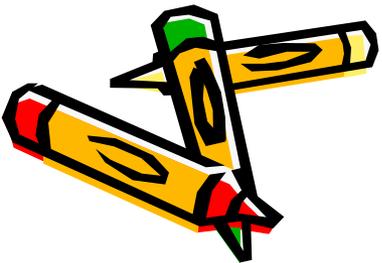




# Being prepared!

Siam and performance Poetry (2 weeks)


## GPS

- Handwriting - 3x a week. Work should be joined neatly in all books.





# Spelling

  - Week 5 - Comprehension

  - Homework diaries checked on Monday so please make sure they are signed.

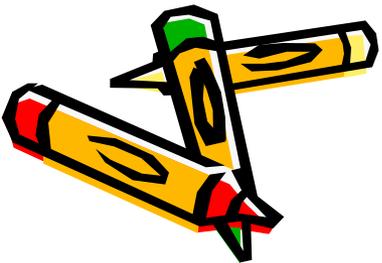



- Sets are fluid - changes will be made when we feel it is appropriate and you will be contacted before.


# PE

- Classes **5LM and 5B** will start swimming on **Wednesday 26th November and continue until 11th February.**


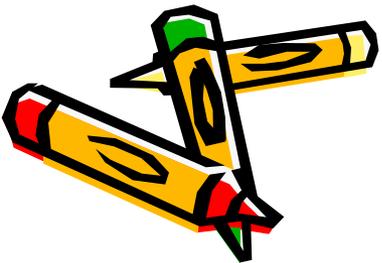
