

VISIT TO BILLERICAY FC FOOTBALL GROUND YEAR 2 TRIP

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you we have arranged an educational visit for the children to Billericay FC ground on 26th and 27th March. This is an opportunity for the children to explore this fantastic local football ground and also learn about the game itself and take part in various activities while there.

The Year 2 classes will attend on the dates below.

Oak and Birch Classes Wednesday 26th March

Elm and Willow Classes Thursday 27th March

Children will come to school and register as usual and we will leave at approximately 9.30am and return to school by 3.00pm. They will need a packed lunch, including a water bottle. **No sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please.**

Children can attend school in their normal school uniform and will then change into their PE kits for the trip. Please ensure that pe kits are in school on this day and that you send in some suitable footwear such as trainers. Please make sure they have a coat in case of inclement weather.

The school is asking for a voluntary contribution of £7.05 per pupil to cover the cost of the coaches and entrance to the venue. No pupil will be excluded from the trip on the basis of non-payment, however if enough contributions are not received then the trip will not be able to take place. If you are in receipt of pupil premium and require a school packed lunch for the trip for your child then please contact the school office.

Payment and consent for the trip should be made using your **ParentPay** account by Monday 17th March. If you are in receipt of pupil premium you will still need to complete the consent form but will not be asked for payment.

We will require some parent helpers for this trip so please contact your class teacher if this is something you can help with. Please note that as a volunteer on a school trip it may not always be possible for you to be placed with your own child.
