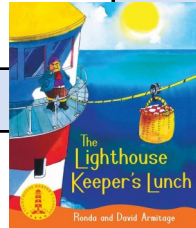


Maths

Our enquiry question for RE this half term is 'Why do people have different ideas about god?' This is a philosophy unit.

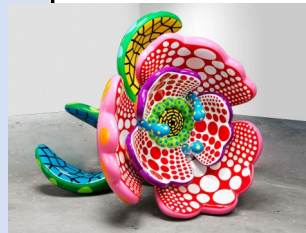
PSHE

The children will be creating a clay flower in the style of Yayoi Kusuma.



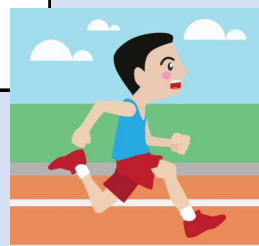
Music
