## Art

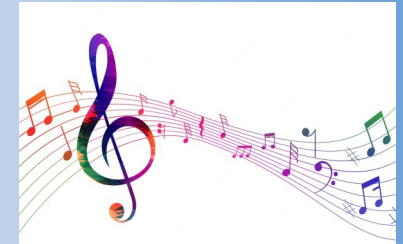
