VISIT TO SEALIFE ADVENTURE SOUTHEND RECEPTION TRIP

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you we have arranged an educational visit for the children to the Sealife Adventure in Southend on **15th and 16th June**. This is an opportunity for the children to explore their recent topic of dinosaurs as well as learning about many different animals and their habitats.

The Reception Classes will take part on the following days.

Badgers and Rabbits Classes **Monday 15th June**
Foxes and Hedgehogs Classes **Tuesday 16th June**

Children will come to school and register as usual and we will leave at approximately 9.30am and return to school by 3.00pm. They will need a packed lunch, including a water bottle. **No sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please.**

Children can attend the trip in their normal school uniform and suitable footwear such as trainers. Please make sure they have a coat in case of inclement weather. If the weather is hot and sunny then sun cream will need to be applied in the morning and a sun hat provided.

The school is asking for a voluntary contribution of £20.74 per pupil to cover the cost of the coaches and entrance to the venue. No pupil will be excluded from the trip on the basis of non-payment, however if enough contributions are not received then the trip will not be able to take place. If you are in receipt of pupil premium and require a school packed lunch for the trip for your child, then please contact the school office.

Payment and consent for the trip should be made using your **ParentPay** account by Friday 5th June. If you are in receipt of pupil premium you will still need to complete the consent form but will not be asked for payment.

We will require some parent helpers for this trip so please contact your class teacher if this is something you can help with. Please note that as a volunteer on a school trip it may not always be possible for you to be placed with your own child.
