

## CHALKWELL BEACH YEAR 2 TRIP

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you we have arranged an educational visit for the children to visit Leigh-on-Sea and then on to Chalkwell beach on 30<sup>th</sup> June and 3<sup>rd</sup> July. This is an opportunity for the children to take part in some geography field work in the town of Leigh on sea and then on to the beach for some fun activities.

The Year 2 classes will attend on the dates below.

Elm and Willow Classes Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June

Oak and Birch Classes Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July

Children will come to school and register as usual and we will leave at approximately 9.30am and return to school by 3.00pm. They will need a packed lunch, including a water bottle. **No sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please.** We would like the children to bring a bucket and spade, a pair of old trainers/jelly shoes and a small towel for paddling up to our ankles (we will not be swimming!) to brush off feet at the end of the day. Please ensure that everything is named!

Children can attend the trip in their normal school uniform with suitable footwear such as trainers. We will be outdoors all day so if the weather is wet please ensure your child has a coat, and if it is hot and sunny please apply sunscreen in the morning and supply a sun hat.

The school is asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.60 per pupil to cover the cost of the coaches. No pupil will be excluded from the trip on the basis of non-payment, however if enough contributions are not received then the trip will not be able to take place. If you are in receipt of pupil premium and require a school packed lunch for the trip for your child then please contact the school office.

Payment and consent for the trip should be made using your **ParentPay** account by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June. If you are in receipt of pupil premium you will still need to complete the consent form but will not be asked for payment.

We will require some parent helpers for this trip so please contact your class teacher if this is something you can help with. Please note that as a volunteer on a school trip it may not always be possible for you to be placed with your own child.
