WILDERNESS FOUNDATION YEAR ONE TRIP

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you we have arranged an educational visit for the children to the Wilderness Foundation in Chatham Green. This is an opportunity for the children to learn about many plants as well as different habitats during their visit.

The classes will be attending on the following days
Woodpeckers and Owls Monday 6th July
Kestrels and Robins Tuesday 7th July

Children will come to school and register as usual and we will leave at approximately 9.30am and return to school by 3.00pm. They will need a packed lunch, including a water bottle. **No sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please.**

Children can attend the trip in their normal school uniform with suitable footwear such as trainers. Please make sure they have a coat in case of inclement weather and a sun hat and sun cream applied in case of sunny weather.

The school is asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.82 per pupil to cover the cost of the coaches and entrance to the venue. No pupil will be excluded from the trip on the basis of non-payment, however if enough contributions are not received then the trip will not be able to take place. If you are in receipt of pupil premium and require a school packed lunch for the trip for your child then please contact the school office.

Payment and consent for the trip should be made using your **ParentPay** account by Monday 29th June. If you are in receipt of pupil premium you will still need to complete the consent form but will not be asked for payment.

We will require some parent helpers for this trip so please indicate on **ParentPay** or contact your class teacher if this is something you can help with. Please note that as a volunteer on a school trip it may not always be possible for you to be placed with your own child.
